

## **30 hour Entitlement (Extended entitlement)**

From September 2017 in response to the government increasing the free early education entitlement for working parents of 3 & 4 year olds from 15 hours to 30 hours, Uffington Primary School will be changing its nursery place provision. From September 2017, parents who meet the eligibility criteria will be entitled to a 30 hours a week funded place (Extended Entitlement).

### **Would you be eligible for the additional 15 hour entitlement for your 3 or 4 year old?**

#### **Basic eligibility criteria:**

- Both parents earning the equivalent of 16 hours at the living wage. Currently £5990.40 a year.
- Neither parent earning more than £100,000
- Lone parents will also be eligible subject to the above criteria

#### **Key points to note:**

- Children are admitted to the nursery in September, January and April.
- If you are eligible, entitlement begins the term after your child is 3. For example if your child was born in February, they would be eligible for funding in April.
